## DERRY COCAINE EPIDEMIC

Since the launching of our first Beir Bua newsletter the 32csm in Derry City have been actively challenging the drug situation in the city. The 32csm have identified the rise of cocaine amongst the working class as currently at epidemic proportions. People who try cocaine often get hooked on short-term cocaine effects, namely feeling of elation and increased energy. However, when users are 'coming down' from the effects they feel depressed and often turn to a prescription drug know as 'Blues' to make themselves feel better. Blues are available from the internet and are often sold by drug pushers alongside cocaine. The knock on effects of the cost of cocaine results in anti social behaviour as consumers often turn to crime to feed their habit. The 32csm is aware that the vast majority of cocaine consumed in working class areas is mixed with other white powders such as crushed painkillers and most notably Creatine, a powder used by bodybuilders to stimulate muscle growth. Since cocaine was introduced into this city suicide rates amongst the young have spiralled out of control and we are in no doubt that drug abuse, alongside the debt that is inflicted by the cost of cocaine are contributing factors. So where are the drugs coming from? The vast majority emanates from Loyalists and is then passed down to peddlers in estates such as Shantallow, Creggan and Gobnascale who are effectively working for loyalist death squads. The RUC/PSNI operating to a Mi5 agenda are happy to turn a blind eye to such activity in the knowledge that drugged up nationalist youths are incapable of recognizing the current occupation and are no use whatsoever to the resistance. One only has to look back to the black communities in America during the eighties.



The CIA flooded black ghettos with drugs in order to keep the black community from rising up. The British have identified this as a tactic in order to normalise the working classes in the six counties, they like to term this as the conflict 'resolution' and drugs are a weapon that are using. Every so often small time pushers will be sacrificed in order protect the RUC/PSNI's integrity. Last year the 32csm threatened to name and shame drug dealers forcing the RUC/PSNI and Provisional Sinn Fein to react by sacrificing Eugene Sheehan, a drug pusher from the Brandywell area. Eugene Sheehan was released the next day into the very same community after the RUC recovered a substantial amount of cocaine from his house Sinn Fein was happy to parade this seizure as a success after the 32csm received a positive reaction following the launch of the Beir Bua and its call to shun drug dealers. If this was a republican caught with anything that could remotely connect him or her with a membership charge he or she would face long periods on remand. This shows where the RUC/PSNI and their MI5 master's priorities lie. If the current trends keep going guns will inevitably fall into the hands of drug gangs, as cities like Dublin and Limerick have already witnessed. The 32csm alone does not have the answers to deal with this epidemic. However, we will attempt to organise communities and other like minded people, in an attempt to remove these drug pushing vermin from our communities who sap the expectations and futures of our sons and daughters to benefit their own pockets. We call on the community to shun drug dealers and to join with us to find an alternative to the pathetic attempts by crown forces and their Sinn Fein allies to remove this scourge from our society.

## THE PRIVILEGE OF JUSTICE!

Recently, the RUC acting on evidence provided by Historical Enquiries Team arrested Kevin Crilly a republican from South Armagh, in relation with the killing of Robert Nairac, an undercover British Solider. As the people of Derry City brace themselves for the outcome of the Bloody Sunday inquiry the 32csm would question the motives the arrest of Kevin Crilly. Kevin admitted on a T.V documentary that he was involved in the killing. However, members of the parachute regiment have also admitted firing shots at innocent civilians on Bloody Sunday. We already know that the perpetrators of Bloody Sunday will not be brought to justice for the slaying of 14 innocent civilians on the streets of Derry. Does the killing of Robert Nairac outweighed the call for justice, that has echoed from the streets of Derry every year at the annual Bloody Sunday rally? Is Britain suggesting that the killing of one of their own should be treated as a 'criminal act' and that the 'murderers' should feel the



full weight of British law, while the Irish should grovel at the hands of inquiries?. The differences between Robert Nairac and Jackie Duddy are obvious, Jackie Duddy spent his time as a keen boxer while Robert Nairac spent his time planning and carrying out massacres such as the slaying of the Miami Show Band and the Dublin and Monaghan bombings. While we sit and wait for Saville's 'grey wash' we should remember the fact that British army murdered fourteen Derry men in broad day light and will never be brought to justice, while countless republicans have to live in fear of the Historical Enquiries Team who could take them away from their families. The message from the British is clear, they will investigate and imprison any Irish man who dared to resist the ongoing occupation, while depriving the Irish people of justice when it comes to their own war crimes such as Bloody Sunday and the countless victims of collusion between themselves and loyalist death squads.

## WHAT EVER HAPPENED TO MARTIN MCGUINNESS?

"The elements within our society who perpetrated this act have nothing to offer, they are without mandate or strategy and represent no one. I would encourage anyone with any knowledge regarding this attack to contact the police immediately and assist them fully in their enquiries. I would also like to commend the selfless actions of the passerby, whose quick thinking saved this police officers life."

Martin speaking to media after he visited a Crown Force police officer who was seriously injured in an IRA car bomb, amazingly he had Custard Creams in one hand and a bottle of Lucozade in the other, so much for the Armalite and the ballot box. Brendan Hughes never had the honour of a visit from Martin in his death bed nor did Francis Hughes' mother. Being the deputy first minister of the British 'Northern Ireland' state-let must be a very busy job and the defenders of the state seem to have more priority than those who once

set out destroy it. Following a joint RSF/32csm protest against Ian Paisley visiting Cork he was quoted saying "Ian Paisley or the so-called Republican Sinn Fein protestors? And I said give me Ian Paisley any-time." Martin said that Paisley only needed a one way ticket into the Bogside after Ian threatened to invade it, oh how things have changed. On Easter Sunday our Martin joined the perpetrators of Ballyseedy in his position as British minister to watch the Free State army parade triumphantly through the streets of Dublin. While Martin McGuinness was in Dublin lapping it up Nationalist youths in Derry were being viscusly beaten and harassed by his new friends in the RUC. A few months before Free State forces moved

in to intern four Derry men outside a border filling station and have held them ever since with no evidence offered against them to the silence of Sinn Fein. Recently, Martin and Mark Durkan lauded the success of the Gardai in their fight against Republicans. Moreover, these two cheerleaders for British occupation want internment brought into the six counties to quell a resurgent IRA.

The next time your Sinn Fein representative says "we don't really mean it, its part of our strategy" slam the door on their face. Lie after lie has been exposed, in the history of Irish republicanism no leadership has stooped as low as Provisional Sinn Fein, and our Martin hasn't just ate a slice of the British cake he has scoffed the lot. ## DERRY 32CSM LAUNCH ANTI UNDERAGE DRINKING CAMPAIGN

The two 32 County Sovereignty Movement Cumann's in Derry City have been contacted by angry residents who are fed up with underage drinking and associated anti social behavior that plague their communities. In response to this the 32csm has hand delivered a letter to all off sales highlighting the fact that most alcohol that falls into the hands of minors is purchased by those who are over the legal age of 18. We have asked all off sales to put their names on carrier bags and to be vigilant to the amount of alcohol people are purchasing and purchasing trends. Most cases were a customer buys two quarter bottles of vodka for instance or ill-regular purchases of cider and other cheap strong drinks that it often fall in to the hand of minors via irresponsible adults. The



32csm will not hesitate when necessary to name and shame suspect off license that supply the underage by operating relaxed I.D policies. Our activists will also monitor off sales at random to make sure these common sense procedures are being followed. We will also name and shame any person caught supplying minors with alcohol, we have placed posters in most off sales warning people that our activists are about and we will not hesitate, when necessary to name and shame. We urge the community and other like minded groups to stand behind us as we have identified drugs and alcohol abuse as one of the main concerns in the working class community. British establishment politicians remain powerless as they are completely out of touch with the nationalist/republican community in this city.
