The **32 County Sovereignty Movement** represent a principled republican voice and a credible alternative to advance republican goals.

Formerly called the 32 County Sovereignty Committee, as in a committee inside Sinn Fein, the members were formally expelled from the party due to voicing their concerns regarding “the failure of the current peace talks to tackle the key issue of Irish Sovereignty” (minutes from the first gathering).

This then led to the formation of a distinct organisation- the **32 County Sovereignty Movement** in December 1997.

Definition of 32 County Sovereignty: the right to have control over all our 32 counties; to operate one government, to enact laws and to regulate activities and commerce.

Objectives of the **32 County Sovereignty Movement**:

The restoration of Irish Sovereignty

To seek to achieve unity amongst the Irish people on the issue of restoring National Sovereignty

To promote the revolutionary ideas of Republicanism

To involve itself in resisting all forms of colonialism and imperialism

To seek the immediate and unconditional release of all Irish Republican Prisoners throughout the world

Not once have we heard a declaration from British authorities stating their long term intentions towards Ireland. The **32 County Sovereignty Movement** have a view of pursuing and attaining this by 2016.

Membership of the **32County Sovereignty Movement** is open to all who adhere to the Declaration of Independence.

Acceptance of Partition?

Over recent years the spread of the republican message has been hindered greatly due to the deliberate censorship of coverage on matters concerning the Northern conflict by our main National broadcasters. In contrast to this, propaganda against the movement has been given free reign without consequence.

Ignoring republicans has become the devious and damaging strategy of the establishment parties and it is this marginalisation of the republican movement that has paved the way for the acceptance of partition by the general public. The normalisation of the partition of our country will not work. It cannot be allowed to work.

Republicans have been marginalised for continuing to resist partition. It is because of this marginalised state that we are ineffective, and it is this issue we must first address. The **32 County Sovereignty Movement** call on republicans to show solidarity and work together in the areas of protests, commemorations and publicity. Republicans cannot be ignored if our strength is realised.



Local Heroes

Remembrance Corner:

Eddie Carmody was born in Moyvane, Co. Kerry. At a young age he moved to Ballylongford to work on a local farm. He was an outstanding Gaelic footballer and an all round athlete. He was a man of great courage, honesty and innate chivalry. He was one of the first of the local men to join Óglaigh na hÉireann, becoming at first the Quarter Master of his local company, and then a Lieutenant within the IRA. While on his way to an arms dump outside Ballylongford on the 22nd November 1920, he was ambushed by a patrol of Black and Tans. He was severely wounded and after being fired upon several times, he still managed to struggle away a few hundred yards. The Tans, following his trail of blood,

found him after a brief search and dragged him onto the roadway where he was kicked and beaten with rifle butts. After being stabbed by the soldiers' bayonets in a frenzied attack he was shot several times in the face resulting in his death. His body was then put onto a cart and dragged through the village to the local barracks where he was left outside in a turf shed until his father collected his body the following day.
